SYMPOSIUM & SEMINAR LEADERS

Grandmaster Jae Chul Shin

is the founder and head of the World Tang Soo Do Association and direct student of Grandmaster Hwang Kee, founder of Moo Duk Kwan. His Association has 100,000 members in 36 countries. After receiving a Master's degree from Korea University, he came to the United States in 1968. His six fields of expertise include self-defense, forms, breaking, weapons, health care, and meditation. He is recognized throughout the world as an expert in Korea's traditional martial art of Tang Soo Do



Dr. Ed Thomas

is an internationally recognized kinesiologist with over thirty-years of teaching experience at numerous schools including The University of Iowa, Northern Illinois University and Emory University. He is a Fulbright Scholar, martial artist and Army physical readiness-training expert. Thomas has been widely quoted in the media and has published dozens of articles. He has worked and studied abroad in Korea, Germany, Burma, and Thailand.

Dr. He-Young Kimm

is the founder and head of the World Han Moo Do Association with affiliates throughout the US and the World. He is a distinguished scholar who has devoted much of his life to the study of Korean Martial Arts. Since retiring from his position as a college president, he has traveled extensively in North and South Korea to do research for his book on Korean Martial Arts, which is ten-years in the making. He is a prolific and well-respected writer of Martial Art history, philosophy and technique.



Grandmaster Woo Jin Jung

is owner and publisher of Tae Kwon Do Times Magazine. He has 45 branch schools throughout the country and seven health clubs as well as other business ventures. The U. S. Government named him Iowa Minority Small Business Person of the Year (1986); in addition, he was part of a trade delegation to China with the State of Iowa. Grm. Jung has been instrumental in helping to open North Korea to the world through "Tae Kwon Do diplomacy."

Grandmaster Kwang Jo Choi

is the founder and President of Choi Kwang Do International with affiliates in 30 countries. He created Choi Kwang Do because of severe injuries he received while executing traditional techniques. He moved to America for treatment in 1970 but decided to try rehabilitating his body without surgery. He studied and became an expert in anatomy, physiology, human-movement sciences, and physical therapy. He slowly healed his condition, and then incorporated all he had learned into his new martial system, creating a safer art based on biomechanical principles.



Mayor Jin S. Yang

is a Martial Arts Master who has dedicated much of his life to serving the public through government office. Mr. Yang has served on the Town Council of Corte Madera, California, and as the town's vice-mayor. He currently is Mayor of Corte Madera and is the Chairman of the Twin Cities (Corte Madera, Larkspur) Police Council. Mayor Yang has worked closely with large and small businesses in his city. As a former martial art instructor owning his own business and now as a mayor, he thoroughly understands how local government can assist the business owner to succeed.
